

**BYLAWS  
PAST LT. GOVERNORS' ASSOCIATION  
OF THE  
FLORIDA DISTRICT  
OF KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL**

**ARTICLE I. NAME AND TERRITORIAL LIMITS**

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be the Past Lt. Governors' Association of the Florida District of Kiwanis International (the "Association").

Section 2. The territorial limits of this Association shall be confined to the state of Florida and the Cayman Islands.

**ARTICLE II. OBJECTS**

Section 1. The objects of this Association shall be to promote and enhance the objectives of Kiwanis by providing support to the Florida District Officers, Board and Foundation, while offering on a non-intrusive, continuing basis, the value of past experience to all current and future Lt. Governors.

b. Annual Member. An annual fee of \$5 entitles the member to membership for a period beginning on the date payment is made and ending on the day of the next succeeding annual meeting. Members who do not annually renew their membership will not be subject to a "make-up" charge for any year(s) of non-membership.

**ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1. This Association shall be open to all Past Lt. Governors of any District of Kiwanis International who are currently active, senior or privileged members of a Kiwanis Club in the Florida District of Kiwanis International.

Section 2. Membership shall be of two classes:

a. Life Member. A one-time fee of \$50 entitles the member to membership for life.

**ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS**

Section 1. The officers of the Association shall be a President, President-Elect, and Secretary-Treasurer.

Section 2. The Terms of all officers shall begin on the date of election at the annual meeting.

Section 3. Each officer shall have the duties of promoting the Objects of the Association, the Objects of Kiwanis and the interest of the Clubs within the Florida District of Kiwanis International.

Section 4. The President shall have the further duties and responsibilities of:

a. Presiding at all meetings of the Association.

b. Communicating with all members of the Association and current Lt. Governors, as required to promote the Objects of the Association.

Section 5. The President-Elect shall support the President and will assume the duties of the President in the absence of the President.

Section 6. The Secretary-Treasurer shall

a. Prepare the correspondence for the Association and keep the minutes of the meetings of the Association.

b. Keep the books and manage the financial affairs for the Association.

c. Make a report at the annual meeting.

Section 7. In the event of a vacancy in any office, the next junior officer will assume the vacated office and will perform the duties of both the assumed and original office. In the event of a vacancy in the office of Secretary-Treasurer, the President shall name a member of the Association to that office, to serve until the next annual meeting. The office will be deemed to be vacant for the purpose of elections at the next annual meeting.

#### **ARTICLE V. ELECTIONS**

Section 1. The election of officers will be by voice vote of all members in good standing and present at the annual meeting.

Section 2. The President-Elect will be the sole candidate for the office of President.

Section 3. The Secretary-Treasurer will be the sole candidate for the office of President-Elect.

Section 4. The candidate for the office of Secretary-Treasurer and candidates for any vacant offices shall be offered to the Association by a nominating committee. The nominating committee shall consist of the currently sitting officers of the Association and the Governor, Governor-Elect, Treasurer and Executive Director-Secretary of the Florida District of Kiwanis International. Eligible candidates shall consist of all individuals eligible for membership as well as members of the class of Lt. Governors whose term will end on the September 30<sup>th</sup> following the annual meeting.

Section 5. Candidates may be nominated from the floor for any vacant office.

#### **ARTICLE VI. MEETINGS**

Section 1. The annual meeting of the Association will be held at the District Convention of the Florida District of Kiwanis International at such time and place as the Executive Director-Secretary of the Florida District of Kiwanis International determines.

Section 2. Notice of the District Convention duly sent to members of the Florida District of Kiwanis International shall be deemed to be notice of the Association's annual meeting.

#### **ARTICLE VII. AMENDMENTS**

Section 1. Amendments to these Bylaws may be made by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members in good standing at any annual meeting.

Section 2. Amendments may be proposed by any member in good standing and shall be received by the Secretary-Treasurer not later than sixty (60) days prior to the annual meeting.

District Convention notifications to members of the District. The reasonable costs of publication shall be borne by the Association if requested by the Executive Director-Secretary of the Florida District of Kiwanis International.

Section 3. Notice of a proposed amendment shall be distributed with the
